Directions to Alpine Scout Camp

By bus: Take the Red and Tan Bus (#9A) from 175th St. at Port Authority terminal (G.W. Bridge) to Alpine Scout Camp (approx. \$10 roundtrip).

By car from New York City: Travel to the George Washington Bridge taking the upper level. Take your first exit on your right in New Jersey (Palisades Pkwy North). Travel 9 miles to exit 2 - "Alpine Approach Road". Follow the exit around under the Parkway to a traffic light (this will be Route 9W). Make a right hand turn and travel north for about 1-1/4 miles. Alpine Scout Camp will be on your left-hand side.

By car from New Jersey: From southern or mid-New Jersey, you can take either the New Jersey Turnpike or Garden State Parkway to Interstate 80. Travel on I-80 to the last exit before the George Washington Bridge toll (this will be in Fort Lee). The exit will say Route 9 and Palisades Parkway. You may then take either Route 9W for 10 miles to Camp Alpine (it will be on your left), or get on to the Palisades Parkway and follow directions above.
